FORMAT: USEF/EVUSA rules apply with USEF rules superseding EVUSA when there is any conflict. Please review new USEF rules. All participating vaulters, lungers, and coaches must be AVA members in good standing by the close of entries, March 29, 2023 or pay the EVUSA non-member fee before beginning competition. Signature of a coach registered with the club is required on page 4. All vaulters, lungers, horse owners, coaches and trainers participating in USEF recognized classes must be USEF members in good standing or pay the \$45 USEF Show Pass fee. Vaulters not in compliance with current USEF/EVUSA requirements will forfeit any awards.

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management whose decision shall be final. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be the condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise. The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees. Show management reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the show without being liable for compensation. In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act, which restricts the disposal of medical waste, biohazardous medical waste containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of this waste. No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those having official or requested duties to perform. It is the tradition of the show that riders be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed and the horses properly presented. Management may in its discretion bar any person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

Each Vaulter, parent for minor vaulter, coach, owner, groom, lunger (coach may sign for all) must sign under the USEF federation agreement, the USEF waiver, the EVUSA waiver and the Garrod Farms release forms online by April 12, 2023.

DEADLINE: Entries must be submitted online with payment and forms mailed no later than midnight March 29, 2023. Entries by mail postmarked no later than March 28, 2023 to Christina Cagliostro 22530 Mt. Eden Road Saratoga CA 95070. NO post entries allowed. Any mail requiring a signature will be refused. incorrect or late paperwork fines will be assessed and charged to the club (ex-missing or incorrect horse numbers, names, missing releases). It is a 25\$ flat fee for each item. There is a 25\$ fine for incomplete or late music. This also includes any late entries or paperwork received after March 29, 2023. Specifically, permission forms turned in after April 12 will have a #25 fee for each item, and all other changes that occur after the first posted OOG (with the exception of horse use within a go) will incur a \$25 charge. Drops will not be refunded unless a medical note is provided. A blank check made out to MEVC will be required from each club at check in. All late/incorrect/changes and mailing charges will be put on the check, and the club will be notified via email of the total charge.

COVID Notice: All national, state, and local guidelines for COVID-19 will be followed. We ask that anyone who has had any sickness or symptoms related to COVID-19 not come to the competition facility. If you have tested positive for COVID, you must have self-quarantined for at least 14 days and are currently symptom free. Masks must be worn at all times unless practicing, warming up, or competing in the warm up and/or competition arenas. Clubs are to social distance from other clubs, vaulters should not intermingle with vaulters from another club. Hand sanitizers will be available throughout the competition arena and the barn. We ask that you not sign up for this fest if you are at all worried about COVID-19. COVID-19 rules may change as we approach competition time. We will keep coaches informed and up to date if there are any changes.

REFUNDS: No refunds after April 12, 2023 without doctor/vet note and refund request form.

ORDER OF GO: A preliminary OOG will be posted online by April 12, 2023.

DRAW: Draw will be done by computer on April 1 at 22530 Mt. Eden Road Saratoga.

MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT, WAIVERS AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, **Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon** payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. In consideration of Equestrian Vaulting USA("the EVUSA") allowing the undersigned ("Participant"), or on behalf of my child/ward, if Participant is under the age of 18 ("a Minor"), to participate in any capacity (i.e.- vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in any EVUSA event or activity, including but not limited to clinics, practices, fests, competitions and/or related or incidental activities ("EVUSA Event(s)"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and or assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

- A. **RULES AND REGULATIONS**: I hereby agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of the EVUSA and on the website at www.equestrianvaulting.org, as amended from time to time.

I acknowledge that incidents arising out of but not limited to: the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of equipment; inadequate safety measures; and any and all situations beyond the immediate control of the EVUSA and EVUSA Event(s)' organizers and or competition

- C. **ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** I understand that the Risks may be caused in whole or in part directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own or others' actions or inactions, or the negligent acts or omissions, including but not limited to gross negligence, of the Released Parties defined below, and I do voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any EVUSA Events. Motorized Vehicle Statement

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
