USEF MEMBERS

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

NATIONALS QUALIFYING CRITERIA

Scores may be obtained from a EVUSA, USEF, or FEI recognized competition at which the class is judged by at least two licensed judges.

Qualifying Criteria:

- Qualifying Scores
 - Scores can be earned at competitions held after the end of 2023 Nationals and before the Close of Entries for 2024 Nationals.
 - Competitors must submit proof of qualifying scores with Nationals entry via [the google form linked here](#).
 - Once a competitor has received the required qualifying score(s) they are auto-invited to Nationals – no letter will be sent.
- Individual competitors require TWO qualifying scores at the level for which the individual is qualifying.
 - Qualifying Scores
 - 3* - 6.50 Overall
 - 2* Young/Gold – 6.10 Overall
 - 2* Silver – 6.00 Overall
 - 1* Bronze – 5.70 Overall
 - 1* Copper – 5.50 Overall
 - 1* Trot – 5.30 Overall
 - East Fest 2023 Individual scores may be used as ONE of your scores to qualify for Nationals 2024
- Pas de Deux (all levels) requires ONE overall score at the Pas de Deux level for which the pair is qualifying.
 - Pas de Deux must have the same partners (no substitutes)
- All Teams/Squads, with the exception of 2-Phase Teams, require ONE overall score at the level for which the team/squad is qualifying.
 - No more than two substitutes from the original entered team may be used at Nationals.
- No overall score is required for a 2-Phase Team

TRYON FESTIVAL

Qualifying scores achieved at this festival can count as one of the qualifying scores required for participation in the 2024 National Championships.

Tryon Festival - Qualifying Scores for 2024 National Championships

For an Individual score earned at Tryon Festival to be counted as one of the two qualifying scores necessary to participate in the 2024 National Championships, all vaulters must:

- Enter to compete in the Tryon Festival in the EVUSA class at the level for which the vaulter is competing to qualify, and
- Enter to compete in the 2024 USEF/EVUSA Nationals Championships for the classes at the level for which the individual is seeking to qualify.
- Vaulters must submit proof of qualifying scores achieved at one qualifying competition and select "Tryon Festival" as the competition for the second qualifying score - Nationals office will monitor scores from the Tryon festival classes ONLY for the vaulters who select Tryon Festival as the second competition to achieve a qualifying score.
- ALL VAULTERS MUST be registered for both events by close of entries.
- EACH FEST'S APPLICABLE REGISTRATION FEES/COSTS as set out in the respective prize list will apply when registering for either competition.

If the individual qualifying 2nd score is not reached, vaulters may apply for a refund of 50% of the Nationals class entry fee.

NOTE: Fees pertaining to vaulter, lunge, and horse registration, or other fees are non refundable in the event an individual qualifying 2nd score is not reached. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

This competition is recognized by both the USEF and the EVUSA. USEF rules will apply for all USEF classes offered and the classes will be judged in accordance with USEF rules. EVUSA rules will apply for all EVUSA classes offered and the classes will be judged in accordance with EVUSA rules. Please review the current EVUSA rule book. The current EVUSA rule book is posted at www.equestrianvaulting.org. THE ENTIRE COMPETITION IS SUBJECT TO THE APPLICABLE USEF GENERAL RULES AND POLICIES GOVERNING LICENSED COMPETITIONS, INCLUDING EQUINE AND ATHLETE SAFETY AND WELFARE.

ENTRIES: All entries must be submitted by 11:59PM July 17st, 2024 PST via HorseSportPro (<https://horsesport.pro/Login>) including digital submission of all waivers and payment. Post entries will be accepted until July 24th (subject to \$200 fee). Each participant must complete the entry form including all numbers and signatures. MEMBERSHIP: Individuals, including vaulters, coaches and lungers, who are not current EVUSA members as of the start of the first day of competition must pay a non-member fee in order to participate in an EVUSA Recognized Competition. All vaulters, lungers, coaches, horse owners, and trainers participating in USEF recognized events must be USEF members in good standing. Vaulters not in compliance with current USEF/EVUSA requirements will forfeit any awards.

PAYMENT: All registration fees must be paid electronically/on-line. Payments are submitted securely online by credit card through [2024 National Championships-Fees](#) All payments must be received by close of entries, July 17TH, 2024. Payments received after July 17, 2024 will be charged a \$10 per vaulter late fee up to a \$200 fee. Any entry fees not received by EVUSA by midnight (PST) on August 8th, 2024 will result in elimination from the competition.

HOLD HARMLESS RELEASE FORMS: All vaulters, lungers, coaches, horse owners, and trainers must sign the electronic waiver. Both parent/guardian and competitor must sign for minors. All release forms MUST be electronically signed using the Smartwaiver link.

REFUNDS: After close of entries the registration fees and class fees for vaulters and lungers are non-refundable. In case of injury to a participant or a horse before the start of the competition, refunds will be provided less the applicable \$25 Registration Fee, only if show management is notified in writing of the scratch before the competition starts and the appropriate medical documentation is provided. Show management reserves the right to decide all issues related to potential refunds whether due to documented changes in entries or incorrect assessment of fees. All refunds will be processed after the close of the competition and provided to participating clubs if appropriate. All requests for refunds must be made using the [Nationals Refund Request Google Form](#). All requests for refunds must include a submitted Refund Form and a note from a doctor or veterinarian and must be received by nationalsreg@equestrianvaulting.org no later than August 12, 2024 then the case may be reviewed. If the event is canceled due to unforeseen circumstances, monies will be refunded minus a management fee. **Refund checks will be mailed to clubs only (not individuals) no later than September 30, 2024.**

CLASS SCHEDULE: Classes may be canceled or added at show management discretion.

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for Safe Sport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. OFFICE: The show office will be staffed on Thursday, August 8th at 1pm. The office will be open from start of competition until 15 minutes after the close of competition daily. A list of staff members and their positions will be posted. Please direct your questions to the appropriate person. The Scoring Office is off limits to ALL but assigned workers, management, and judges.

T-SHIRTS: One T-shirt is included with each entry. Custom order your size through the [Google Form](#). If no size is noted, the default size will be Adult Medium. Youth Sizes S, M, L XL. Adult Sizes S, M, L, XL, and XXL. Additional T-shirts may be ordered via the google form and payment submitted with the form. **One google form per club with all participants and extra shirt orders will be accepted.**

HORSES CHECK IN: All horses may be checked at the gate for completed horse paperwork which includes, health certificate (out of state horses) and negative coggins. Horses may only arrive at the facility after 8am beginning Thursday, August 8th, 2024.

CHECK-IN: Check In will be Thursday, August 8th, 2024 between 1pm and 6pm. All paperwork must be completed and on file before the check-in. No horses are allowed on site before 8am Thursday, August 8th, 2024. At check-in each club/independent is required to designate who will be allowed to sign change forms for that club.

VET CHECK: All participating horses must go through the Vet Check on Friday, August 9th, 1:00 PM in the Main Arena. Horses presented at Vet Check are eligible for the Horse Travel grant monies (see page 12). The specific order will be posted in the show office and in the barn. Horses will go in club alphabetical order and must be ready in order or face possible elimination. Horses are to be presented in bridle; handler to be dressed suitably. Horses must present at Vet Check to compete at Nationals.

ORDER OF GO: The draw for Order of Go for all classes will be performed by computer before July 31st. Please review and email conflicts/changes to nationalsreg@equestrienvaulting.org as soon as possible. All changes made on or after August 5th will incur a \$25 per change fee; changes made on or after August 8th will incur a \$50 per change fee.

VOLUNTEERS: Jobs will be posted after the Order of Go is posted. Every competing club is required to provide an equitable number of volunteer hours to match their number of vaulters. NO EXCEPTIONS! Clubs are not allowed practice time at the competition until the required number of jobs for their club are filled. We strongly recommend that each club bring enough ADULT non-vaulters to fill their volunteer requirements. All jobs must be filled by **August 5th, 2024**. Clubs unable to fulfill the volunteer requirement may have the option to pay a \$30 fee for each unfilled job. Please contact the Volunteer Coordinator, Michele Moore at nationalsvol@equestrienvaulting.org, if your club has any issues.

VOLUNTEER ATTIRE: Nationals may be live streamed and all workers/volunteers entering the competition arena (gate managers, gate assistants, ushers, runners, day managers, arena scorers, etc.) should be neatly attired in Khaki or Black bottoms with a Navy Blue or Black Shirt.

MEDIC/EMT: A 'Qualified Medical Person' will be on site during competition and warm-up schedule times. No vaulting on horses allowed unless an EMT is on site.

WARM UP: Only those competitors on-deck or warming up (as directed by gate steward) are allowed in the warm-up arena and on deck arenas. There will be designated riding warm-up. All riders must wear an approved helmet that meets the requirements of USEF GR801 when mounted.

Practice Schedule: A practice schedule will be posted on HorseSportPro (in the links document) with pre-assigned times for each registered horse in the competition arena. Additional practice time will be available on site - check with Blue gate manager. Clubs will not be allowed in the arena to practice until all volunteer requirements have been filled.

ARENAS & FOOTING: The competition arena is 135' x 230' with engineered all weather footing. Riding and lunging arena is 250' x 150' with engineered all weather footing. Competition arenas are more than 16.6' in height.

GATE TIMES: Please plan to attend all three days. Gate times will be adhered to, with the exception of medical emergencies. Competitors are responsible for being at the appropriate gate at least 10 minutes before the assigned time. Keep an eye on the competition as classes may be running early. Any competitor not ready to enter the competition arena at the assigned time may be eliminated from the class.

Numbers: Individual vaulters and lungers must wear their EVUSA number in accordance with current EVUSA and USEF rules. Horses must wear their EVUSA number on their bridle. Team members must wear numbers per EVUSA rules. Paying Non-Members will be assigned a temporary number.

BARRELS: Club camps and barrels will be allowed ONLY in designated areas. Barrel practice must be supervised by club coaches at all times. No unsupervised barrel use is permitted. Only registered participants may use the barrels.

FOOD: TIEC has 7 different restaurants on site as well as a General Store.

Ice Cream Social: The Ice Cream Social will be held Friday afternoon (2:30pm)- More information will be provided. Each competitor will receive a ticket with their registration.

DOGS: All dogs must be on a leash at all times. Owners must clean up after their dogs. No dogs allowed in the stands of the competition arenas or vaulting barns unless a certified service animal.

DISQUALIFICATION:

- Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges, steward or officials by a coach, lunger, vaulter, parent, or club affiliate shall disqualify those individuals from further competition and the individual and/or club shall forfeit their entire entry and related fees.
- Inhumane treatment of a horse on the grounds is forbidden and will result in disqualification of the offender(s) from competition.
- Judges have the right to dismiss from competition any horse which is uneven, unlevel, in bad condition, which shows signs of discomfort or fatigue, or which endangers the safety of participants.
- Failure to be on time to classes will result in disqualification, except in case of a conflict of schedule which has been approved by show management.

AWARDS: All classes will be awarded overall ribbons to 15th place. Award ceremonies will be held on the day all sections in a division are completed. All placed vaulters are expected to attend the Awards Ceremonies in team attire. The gate manager will not admit unsuitably attired participants into the arena for awards. There are separate divisions for Men and Women in Individual 1* Trot, 1* Copper, 1* Bronze, 2* Silver, 2* Young Vaulter/Gold, and 3* levels. Champion and Reserve horses must attend and 3rd place horses may attend (optional). Horses attending awards ceremony must be in bridle and braided.

USEF:

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT:

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT:

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Lunger and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of The Mount Holyoke May Day Vaulting Fest (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

MUSIC INFORMATION

In HorseSportPro, each club's music is self-service. The competition will play what it has received. The music deadline is midnight PST Wednesday July 31st, 2024. Only the Entry Manager for a club (the person who initially logged on to the system and who made the class entries) can upload music into HorseSportPro.

- Once class entries are present, you can assign piece of music to each test (compulsory, freestyle, tech test)
- Music names are not important for management except Run In/Out (auto identified with the wording RUN IN included in the music file name.
 - If your club uses more than one version of run in music, then for each of the club goes, the music playing person will have to select the correct run in based on the names e.g. "copper_run_in" versus "trot_run_in"
- Scratches will still appear as requiring music

All music played at EVUSA sanctioned events must be properly-licensed to avoid possible music copyright infringement liability. ASCAP and/or BMI libraries may be readily checked through SongView (<https://songview.com/>). Please note ASCAP and BMI may each hold a partial interest in a song. For example, ASCAP might own 80% and BMI might own 20%; but total shares held by both must total 100%.

The Music assignment ability CLOSES (Entry LOCK date) August 1st. Music needing to be uploaded or changed after the Entry Lock date will be subject to a \$25 late fee per file (not to exceed \$500) and require management's assistance.

HORSES AND STABLING INFORMATION

WELFARE OF THE HORSE: The EVUSA requires all those involved in the sport of vaulting to adhere to the Code of Conduct for the welfare of the horse and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the Horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

HORSES: All USEF rules pertaining to horses govern ALL horses participating on any day of competition. The judge may excuse from competition any horse which is unsound or otherwise unsuitable. All participating horses MUST be registered with USEF (www.usef.org). All horse owners and trainers of horses in USEF classes must be USEF members. Horses not participating in any USEF classes must still be registered with USEF but their owners and trainers need not be USEF members. Isolation stall number and location will be posted at the show office.

NATIONALS 2024 HORSE TRAVEL GRANTS: There is \$7,500 earmarked as horse travel grants for Nationals for every horse who carries at least one vaulter in a class. Grants amounts will be proportionate to the distance from the address of the club where the horse is registered to Nationals.

HORSES CHECK IN: All horses will be checked at the gate for completed horse paperwork which includes, health certificate, negative coggins. Horses may arrive at the facility after 8am Thursday, August 8th, 2024. No early stabling requests are available at this time. All horses must leave TIEC by 9am Monday, August 12th.

COGGINS and HEALTH CERTIFICATES: A negative coggins must be provided for each horse brought to the facility, EHV vaccination (recent as of year 2024). Rhino/Flu vaccination must be done within 6 months of show. A recent (within 30 days) health certification must be provided for any horse crossing a state line into North Carolina. PLEASE NOTE VACCINE REQUIREMENTS. A copy of all papers must be submitted via this [Horse Documentation Link](#).

BUDDY HORSES: All buddy horses must be in bridle and handlers must be properly presented. Handlers may be in riding attire, lunging attire or other appropriate attire. (No shorts, cutoffs or tank tops). Closed toe shoes required. The gate manager or judges may dismiss any buddy horses that are not properly presented, are disruptive or pose any danger and that horse will not be allowed in the arena (as a buddy horse) for the rest of the competition.

SHARPS CONTAINERS: Sharps containers will be provided in the stabling area for the duration of the competition. Competition management may fine any individual including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles and other sharp disposable instruments.

STABLING: (Thursday, August 8th, 2024 - Monday, August 12th, 2024)

Stalls are approximately 10' x 12' with matted floors. Stalls have solid walls and pipe frame swinging door. The cost of horse stalls for the event is \$280 for 10 x 12. In addition, the cost of tack stalls for the event is \$170. Horses may arrive Thursday, August 8th, 2024 beginning at 8AM and must leave the facility no later than 9AM Monday, August 12th, 2024. 2 bags of shavings are included in every stall. Additional shavings (\$12 per bag) can be purchased through the vaulting show office on site. Hay can also be purchased through the vaulting show office. Clubs are not responsible for stripping stalls. Absolutely no smoking in the barn area or arenas. All stalls and aisles must be kept clean. All manure and used shavings removed from stalls or trailers must be placed in specified areas, not in garbage cans. All aisles and roadways around barns must be kept open per fire regulations.

HORSE TRAILERS: Parking is available in designated areas only.

RV's and CAMPING: RV pads are located conveniently on-site. 30/50 amp hookups - water, electric/power, and sewage at each space.
